The IQA verifier ensures that assessment decisions are consistent, fair and meet the requirements of the awarding organisation. Effective IQA protects learners, supports assessors and maintains the integrity of qualifications. All 18,000 approved centres in the UK are required to have qualified IQA verifiers.
